

# COVID-19 Safe Worship Guidelines

You will need to book prior and bring your ticket along with you to attend worship. We regret that due to COVID-19 restrictions only those with pre-booked tickets can be admitted for Worship.



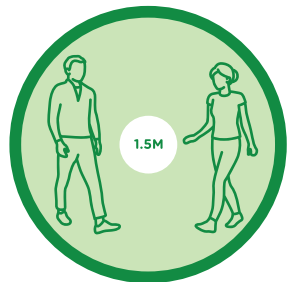
You will be asked to sanitise your hands on entry to the service and prior to receiving communion.



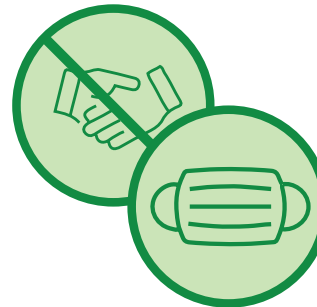
Please do not attend the Cathedral if you are unwell or have any symptoms of Cold or Flu. Our staff will take your temperature using contact-less thermometers and will not admit you if you have a high temperature.



Please remain in your designated seat. Follow the directions of staff for receiving communion and departing at the end of the service.



Keep 1.5m distance from others as you line up, talk with people or sit down, including from family members or people with whom you isolate.



Wear your mask at all times and avoid all physical contact with others, including shaking hands.
